Ionad Cultúrtha runs an art-for-older people programme and also hosts visual art exhibitions on a regular basis.

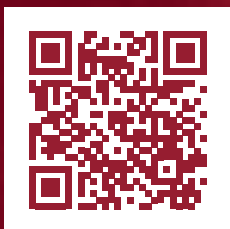
NÓTA AN BHAINISTEORA

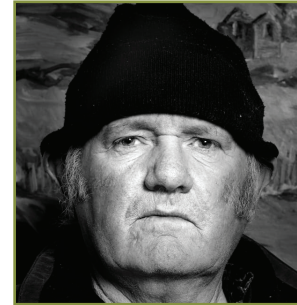

Féachtar ar a n-eisiúint 2021 "Nasc" mar cheann de na halbaim is fearr le blianta beaga anuas ó chulaith Thraidisiúnta Éireannaigh agus bhuaigh sé an t-albam traidisiúnta is fearr i ngradam *raidíó le tacaíocht éisteoir Ceilteach Mheiriceánach 2022*.

Embark on an odyssey of wonder, joyfulness and upbeat music as three incredibly talented and creative folk musicians shape melodies from past and present into something dynamic

and irresistible. A trio comprising of musicians at the fore of our tradition, expect a performance from the gentle to the rhythmical and all the in-betweens.

Co. Clare natives Tara Breen and Pádraig Rynne have teamed up with virtuoso guitarist to form one of the finest performing groups in Irish music today. Their 2021 release "Nasc" is regarded as one of the finest albums in recent years from an Irish Traditional outfit and was winner of the best traditional album in the 2022 American Celtic listener supported radio awards.

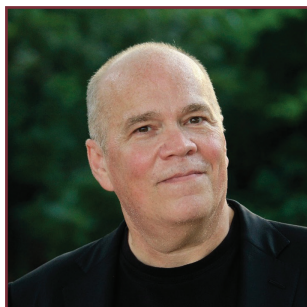


KEANE | CONNOLLY | MCGORMAN

Tá a gceol bríomhar agus úr agus iad faoi thionchar mór máistrí an traidisiúin. Bhí baint ag gach duine acu le tionscadail éagsúla, lena n-áirítear seinnt le Ceolfhoireann Cheolchoirme RTÉ, Gradam Ceoil a bhaint amach, camchuart san Eoraip, Meiriceá agus an Astráil, agus thairfead siad le healaíontóirí cosúil le Dé Danann, Frankie Gavin, Jack Talty, John Blake. Eisíodh a gcéad albam féin-teidil i mí na Nollag 2023.

A quartet of top traditional Irish musicians who spent the majority of their youth playing music together. Featuring uilleann piper Pádraic Keane, Aidan Connolly on fiddle, and brothers Fergus McGorman on flute and Ruairí McGorman on the Greek bouzouki, their music is vibrant and fresh while also heavily influenced by past masters of the tradition. They have each been involved in a variety of projects, including playing with the RTE Concert Orchestra, winning a Gradam Ceoil award, have toured Europe, America and Australia, and have played and recorded with artists such as Dé Danann, Frankie Gavin, Jack Talty, John Blake and many more. Their self-titled debut album was released in December 2023 under the renowned Raelach Records label.

Ros Comáin i 2023. Ó shin bhí Lisa ar fud na hÉireann, Sasana agus Meiriceá, i hallaí ceolchoirme, séipéil, tithe seanscoile, hallaí sráidbhalte agus amharclanna.

Ceangaláíonn ‘Nightvisiting’ an ról sóisialta a bhí ag cuairteanna oíche tithe sóisialta inár dtraidisiúin béil agus béaloidis, agus i gcaomhnú ár n-amhrán agus ár scéalta ó amhráin ghrá geala, go dtí amhráin an chailleanais agus an fhaitiosaigh.

Is ceiliúradh agus athshamhlú é ‘Nightvisiting’ ar na hoícheanta sin ina raibh na sean-amhráin agus na scéalta á roinnt le chéile ag Claire Sherry, Tim Doyle agus Mike Brookfield.

Based on her work with the National Folklore Collection and her recent M.A in Irish Folklore, internationally acclaimed Irish folk singer Lisa Lambe brings us her new project ‘Nightvisiting’, first commissioned by The National Famine Museum in Strokestown, County Roscommon, and since 2023 Lisa has been Nightvisiting all across Ireland, America and the UK in concert halls, churches, old school houses, village halls and theatres.

‘Nightvisiting’ reconnects us to the social role that nighttime social house visits once played in our oral traditions and folklore.

‘Nightvisiting’ is a celebration and a reimagining of those nights of sharing the old songs and stories joined by musicians Claire Sherry, Tim Doyle and Mike Brookfield.

Rooted in realism, the work has developed more story over the years

Getting it right is never a given.

First solo show

“The art world remains unsure about me”

My purpose with painting was to reveal the unseen, or overlooked, beauty of the mundane. While that thread still runs through my work, with time it also began to concern itself with narrative.

I admired Photorealism and trompe l’oeil painting. I like murals for their scale and sign-painting for it’s graphic perfection. I have worked as a sign painter and lettering sometimes finds its way into my pictures. I also like theatre and, as my work progresses, it seems to incorporate more of the theatrical.

Expressing an idea as an engaging painting is a complex affair. Concepts can incubate for years before suddenly blooming. Half-glimpsed ideas can disappear and return in a modified form. Notions that seem full of promise turn out to have no shape. Or maybe the ripening time is simply longer... (perhaps there are notions that blossom after - or originate before - my lifetime). Sometimes ideas arrive fully-formed and assured; ideas that seem to know with certainty the way to the canvas.

The various elements of what will coalesce as a painting can show up anywhere: in a newspaper; in a conversation; in a garden centre.

Rugadh Gerry O’Beirne in Inis, Contae an Chláir, ar chósta thiar saibhir na hÉireann, agus tá clú agus cáil ar mar amhránaí, cumadóir amhrán, léiritheoir ceirníní agus giotáraí, tiple, agus ukulele, giotár sleamhnán agus eile. D’fhás sé aníos in Éirinn agus i nGána san Afraic Thiar, agus tá cónaí air ó shin i Sasana, i gCalifornia agus i Meicsiceo. Tá sé ina chónaí anois in aice leis an Daingean i gCo Chiarraí.

One of the most sought after singers in Ireland, Muireann Nic Amhlaoibh is an award-winning traditional singer and musician from Corca Dhuibhne, Co.Kerry. A leading exponent of the sean nós style, her repertoire also includes songs from a wide variety of folk and contemporary sources.

Multi-instrumentalist Dónal O’Connor has establishing himself as one of Ireland’s leading producers. As a musician and composer he has played and recorded with the likes of Liam Ó Maonlaí, Duke Special, Grainne Holland, Davy Spillane, Moya Brennan.

Born in Ennis, County Clare, along Ireland’s music-rich west coast, Gerry O’Beirne is a renowned singer, songwriter, record producer and guitarist, tiple, and ukulele, slide guitar among others. He grew up in Ireland and in Ghana in West Africa, and has since lived in England, California, and Mexico. He lives now near Dingle in Co Kerry.
